Autumn Leaves

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 58" x 67"

Finished Block Size 9" x 9"

Measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.pennyrosefabrics.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Autumn Hues Fat Quarter Stack (FQ-5220-18)

$1\frac{1}{4}$ yards (1.15 m) cream leaves (C5221 Cream)

$\frac{7}{8}$ yard (85 cm) gold diamond (C5223 Gold)

$\frac{7}{8}$ yard (85 cm) cream tones (C5225 Cream)

$\frac{3}{4}$ yard (70 cm) red tones (C5225 Red)

2 maroon panels (P5226 Maroon)

Binding $\frac{5}{8}$ yard (60 cm)

Backing $3\frac{3}{4}$ yards (3.45 m)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

Fat Quarter Stack

Cut 2 squares 4" x 4" and 4 squares $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " from each of the following assorted prints:

green main, maroon main, green leaves

maroon leaves, maroon medallion, orange medallion

gold diamond, light green diamond, green diamond

green berries, maroon berries, orange tones

Cream Leaves

Cut 6 strips $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for Border 3.

Gold Diamond

Cut 5 strips $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for Border 1.

Cream Tones

Cut 2 strips $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 24 squares $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $2\frac{3}{4}$ ".

Cream Tones (Continued)

Cut 1 strip $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 12 squares $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Cut 3 strips 4" x WOF. Cut the strips into 24 squares 4" x 4".

Red Tones

Cut 6 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for Border 2.

Maroon Panels

Fussy cut 8 squares $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ ".

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the quilt photo for placement of fabrics as each block is different.

Leaf Block

These directions are to make 1 block. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of a cream tones 4" square. Place a cream tones 4" square on top of an assorted print 4" square. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the line. Cut on the lines to make 2 Half Square Triangles. Press. Square up the Half Square Triangles to $3\frac{1}{2}$ ". Repeat to make 4 Half Square Triangles.

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of a cream tones $2\frac{3}{4}$ " square. Place a cream tones $2\frac{3}{4}$ " square in the corner of an assorted print $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Sew on the diagonal. Leave a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance and trim excess. Press. Repeat on the opposite corner to create the Stem Unit.

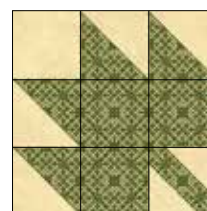


Half Square Triangle



Stem Unit

Referring to block diagram for piece placement, sew 1 cream tones $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square, 4 Half Square Triangles, 3 assorted print $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, and 1 Stem Unit together to create the Leaf Block. Repeat to create 12 Leaf Blocks.

Quilt Center Assembly

Refer to the quilt photo for placement of Leaf Blocks and 9½" panel squares. Lay out blocks in 5 rows of 4 blocks. Sew rows together to complete the center of the quilt.

Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

Border 1

Side borders should be 45½". Top and bottom borders should be 44½".

Border 2

Side borders should be 53½". Top and bottom borders should be 48½".

Border 3

Side borders should be 57½". Top and bottom borders should be 58½".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Penny Rose fabric from the Autumn Hues Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
