## Fabric Requirements

- (A) 3116P-91 ..... 1 panel
- (B) 3121-90 ..... ¼ yard
- (C) 3120-11 ..... 1 ¼ yards\*
- (D) Carbon-23\*\* ..... ⅔ yard
- (E) 3117-99 ..... 1 ¼ yards
- (F) 3118-90 ..... 1 yard

- Backing
- 3118-11 ..... 3 ⅔ yards

- \* Includes Binding
- \*\* Peppered Cottons Collection

## Additional Supplies Needed

- Batting 64" x 80"
- Piecing and sewing thread
- Quilting and sewing supplies

## Cutting

### Cutting Instructions

*Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge.*

WOF= Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric

#### **Fabric A (3116P-91 Panel – Tiffany/Black), cut:**

- Fussy cut (1) block approximately 23" x 43".

#### **Fabric B (3121-90 Pin Stripe – Steel), cut:**

- (2) 2 ¼" x 43" strips.

#### **Fabric C (3120-11 Lace – Tiffany), cut:**

- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, with diagonal seams, and cut
- (2) 1 ½" x 70 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, with diagonal seams, and cut
- (2) 1 ½" x 56 ½" strips.
- (4) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, with diagonal seams, and cut
- (2) 3 ½" x 43" strips and (2) 3 ½" x 32 ½" strips.
- (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### **Fabric D (Carbon-23 Peppered Cottons – Carbon), cut:**

- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, with diagonal seams, and cut
- (2) 1 ½" x 60 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, with diagonal seams, and cut
- (2) 1 ½" x 46 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, with diagonal seams, and cut
- (2) 1 ½" x 46 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 32 ½" strips.

#### **Fabric E (3117-99 Stripe – Black), cut:**

- Fussy cut (1) 13" x LOF strip, centered on the stripe with butterflies. Sub-cut the strip into
- (4) 6 ½" x 13" strips.
- Fussy cut (2) 8" x LOF strips, centered on the stripe with butterflies. Sub-cut the strips into
- (8) 6 ½" x 8" strips.
- Fussy cut (1) 7 ½" x LOF strip, centered on the stripe with butterflies. Sub-cut the strip into
- (2) 6 ½" x 7 ½" strips and (4) 6 ½" squares.
- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip, centered on the stripe with butterflies. Sub-cut the strip into (6) 6 ½" squares.

#### **Fabric F (3118-90 Tossed Hearts – Steel), cut:**

- (4) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, with diagonal seams, and cut
- (2) 4 ½" x 62 ½" strips.
- (3) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, with diagonal seams, and cut
- (2) 4 ½" x 54 ½" strips.

#### **Backing (3118-11 Tossed Harts – Tiffany), cut:**

- (2) 64" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 64" x 80" for the back.

## Sewing

Sew using a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.

### Block Assembly

1. Sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x 43" Fabric B strip to each side of the 23" x 43" Fabric A block (Fig. 1).
2. Sew (1)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 43" Fabric C strip to each side of the Fabric A block. Sew (1)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $32\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the A-block. Trim the block to measure  $30\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $46\frac{1}{2}$ " to make the Center Block (Fig. 2).

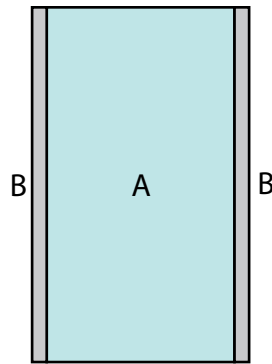

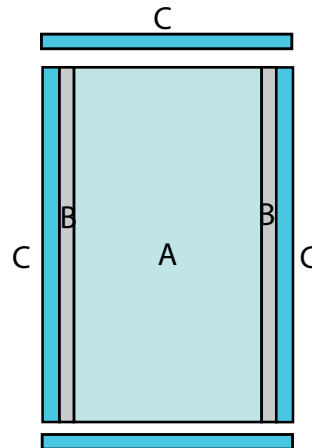

### Quilt Top Assembly

*(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)*

3. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $46\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $32\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
4. Sew (4)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8" Fabric E strips and (3)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E squares together, alternating them, to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of the Center Block. (Pay attention to the orientation of the squares and strips.)
5. Sew (2)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x 13" Fabric E strips, (2)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E squares and (1)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $7\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip together to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
6. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $60\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $46\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
7. Sew (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $62\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $54\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
8. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $70\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $56\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

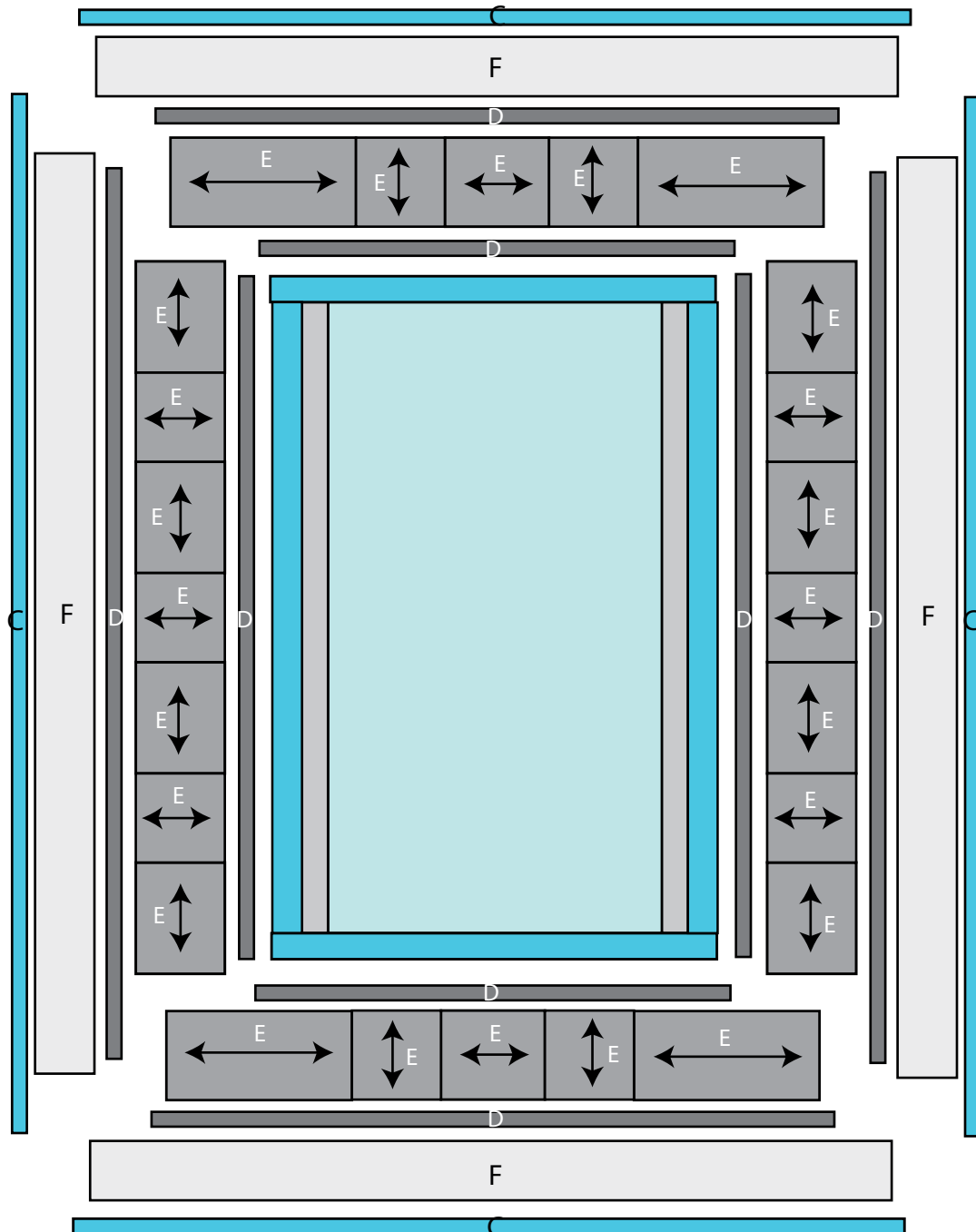
## Layering, Quilting and Finishing

9. Press the quilt top and 64" x 80" backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.

## Binding

10. Cut the ends of the (7) Fabric C binding strips at a 45-degree angle and sew end to end to make (1) continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.

11. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.
